## **HOW DO I APPLY TO VOTE BY POST**

- Fill in the postal vote application form.
- Make sure **YOU** complete all sections of the form and supply your date of birth.
- **3** Return your form as soon as possible to your Electoral Registration Office.

### **VOTING BY POST**

You can apply to vote by post for a particular election, for a set period of time or for all future elections. Postal votes can be sent out to addresses in the UK and abroad.

# WHAT HAPPENS AFTER I'VE RETURNED THIS FORM?

- When an election is going to be held, your ballot paper will be sent to you in the post. Remember, it may not be sent out until four working days before election day.
- If your ballot does not arrive by this time, contact the Returning Officer at your local council for a replacement. The Returning Officer can only issue replacements up to 5.00pm on election day.
- You will need to give your date of birth on this application form, and provide your date of birth when you use your postal vote. This information is needed to tackle fraud.
- Make sure you return your postal vote so that it arrives by election day, otherwise it will not be counted. A freepost envelope is included in your postal ballot pack, however, if you are sending it from overseas, you will need to pay the postage.
- If it is too late to send your vote back by post, you can hand it in on election day to the Returning Officer at your local council or drop it off at a polling station. For further information contact the Returning Officer.
